

## Cheat Sheet MCC Dress Policy

We strive to maintain a uniform code that is neat, clean and modest. We ask our families to help us monitor appropriate dress. Students are expected to be in uniform everyday unless otherwise notified. Students are expected to be in proper school uniform Monday-Thursday. ONLY Friday's are designated as Spirit Days. Full dress policy can be found in the Student Handbook. MCC Administration has final decision on dress policies.

### Daily Uniforms

- **Pants/Shorts/Bottoms**
  - Khaki shorts or pants purchased through uniform supplier only. They must fit properly and be worn at the waist. **Ladies** may also wear capris.
  - All uniform bottoms must be worn properly.
  - Shorts CANNOT be altered in anyway. Shorts cannot be rolled at the cuff.
- **Belt**
  - Solid brown, black, green, white, or conservative belt in nature must be worn.
- **Shirt**
  - Students must wear green collared shirt with MCC Crest purchased through our official supplier.
  - The shirt must be tucked so the belt and waistband of the pants are visible.
- **T-shirts**
  - A solid white or green long or short-sleeve t-shirt may be worn under the polo shirt.
- **Shoes**
  - Should be conservative in nature.
  - Shoes must be closed toe.
  - Shoes must have heel and be worn as designed.
  - Boots are permitted with pants only but must be low cut. **BOOTS may NOT be worn with shorts.**
  - Athletic shoes are the preferred choice.
- **Socks**
  - Socks with designs can worn only if they do not extend higher than 3 inches from ankle.
  - Knee socks of any color or design is NOT permitted.
  - Solid (no design) **neutral** colored leggings or tights may be worn in inclement weather. ONLY neutral tights are permitted under shorts.

### Hair

#### Boys:

- Hair must not touch eyes, mid-ears, or collar.
- Hair must be neat, clean, and well-groomed.
- Completely or partially shaven style hair-cuts, multi-colored or unnaturally colored hair is not permitted.
- Sideburns may extend to the bottom of the ear (no mutton-chops). Dreadlocks may not be worn.
- Boys must be clean-shaven every day or will be required to shave if they are not. Tails or bands to hold the boys' hair back are not permitted.

#### Girls:

- Girl's hair must be her natural color, traditional and unpretentious.
- Non-natural colored highlights are NOT permitted.
- Colored tips are NOT permitted.

### **Mass Day Dress**

#### **Boys:**

- Neatly pressed, tucked in MCC uniform white oxford shirt, pants and their MCC uniform tie. All buttons must be fastened and the tie knotted appropriately.

#### **Girls**

- Neatly pressed MCC uniform white oxford shirt and pants/capris.

### **Outerwear (Club/Athletic wear must receive prior approval by the administration.)**

#### **Sweatshirt and Jackets:**

- School-issued sweatshirts and team sweatshirts.
- **SWEATSHIRTS WITH HOODS ARE PERMITTED however will be confiscated if the hood is seen worn while on campus.**
- School shirts are required under all outerwear at all times.

### **Spirit Days (Non-school uniform day)**

- **Spirit Days are only permitted on Friday's.**
- On spirit days students may wear only MCC school shirt, MCC House Shirt, MCC related t-shirt or the named theme of the day.
- T-shirts must represent an official MCC sponsored event or extracurricular activity.
- School uniform bottoms are the ONLY acceptable attire allowed.
- Shoes must meet all regular dress uniform guidelines.

\*A student who does not meet the guidelines or one who takes a SPIRIT day without permission will not be able to attend class until they are in proper uniform.

### **Cold Weather Attire**

Deviations from MCC dress policy will be announced if the temperature drops to below 40 degrees. Do not assume policy deviation unless announced from Administration. Please make sure your uniform attire includes approved outerwear.
